10 conclusions of law in any order regarding the actual costs of the
11 investigation or proceedings under section 374.046, or the classification
12 of any violation under section 374.049, shall be subject to de novo
13 review.

14 2. A rule adopted by the director is subject to judicial review in
15 accordance with the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo.

16 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
17 no person or entity shall impose an accident response service fee on or
18 from an insurance company, the driver or owner of a motor vehicle, or
19 any other person. As used in this section, the term "accident response
20 service fee" means a fee imposed for the response or investigation by
21 a local law enforcement agency of a motor vehicle accident.

374.150. 1. All fees due the state under the provisions of the insurance
2 laws of this state shall be paid to the director of revenue and deposited in the
3 state treasury to the credit of the insurance [department] dedicated fund unless
4 otherwise provided for in subsection 2 of this section.

5 2. There is hereby established in the state treasury a special fund to be
6 known as the "[Department of] Insurance Dedicated Fund". The fund shall be
7 subject to appropriation of the general assembly and shall be devoted solely to the
8 payment of expenditures incurred by the department [of insurance] attributable
9 to duties performed by the department for the regulation of the business of
10 insurance, regulation of health maintenance organizations and the
11 operation of the division of consumer affairs as required by law which are
12 not paid for by another source of funds. Other provisions of law to the contrary
13 notwithstanding, beginning on January 1, 1991, all fees charged under any
14 provision of chapter 325, 354, 374, 375, 376, 377, 378, 379, 380, 381, 382, 383, 384
15 or 385, RSMo, due the state shall be paid into this fund. The state treasurer
16 shall invest moneys in this fund in the same manner as other state funds and any
17 interest or earnings on such moneys shall be credited to the [department of]
18 insurance dedicated fund. The provisions of section 33.080, RSMo,
19 notwithstanding, moneys in the fund shall not lapse, be transferred to or placed
20 to the credit of the general revenue fund unless and then only to the extent to
21 which the unencumbered balance at the close of the biennium year exceeds two
22 times the total amount appropriated, paid, or transferred to the fund during such
